

FAQ:

a. I'M A NEW POSTGRADUATE STUDENT. CAN I BRING MY SPOUSE AND CHILDREN TO APPLY FOR DEPENDANT PASS?

NO. Students MUST travel to Malaysia as a single traveller. You can apply for Dependant Pass after a student pass is issued to the student (Principle). Your dependant may overstay while waiting for the student pass process to be completed. Overstaying is an offence in Malaysian Law. Immigration Department will impose a penalty for overstaying in Malaysia or family may be blacklisted and deported back to your home country. In some cases, you are prohibited to enter Malaysia for a period of time.

b. MY BABY IS BORN IN MALAYSIA. IS THE BABY REQUIRED TO HAVE A DEPENDANT PASS?

For a newborn baby born in Malaysia, a Dependant Pass need to be applied as soon as possible. However, a passport for the newborn baby is also required for the Dependant Pass application.

c. HOW MUCH WOULD THE DEPENDANT PASS COST?

1. The Dependant Pass fee is RM90 per person (for both first time and renewal applications)
2. Multiple Entry Visa Fees (for both first time and renewal applications). The fee varies according to the nationality of the applicant.
3. Journey Performed Fee is RM500 (for first time application only)
